Matthew 5:1-12 – The Beatitudes (ESV)

1. Matthew 5:1-2 – “Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him. And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying:”
2. Matthew 5:3– “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.”
3. Matthew 5:4 – “Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.”
4. Matthew 5:5 – “Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.”
5. Matthew 5:6 – “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.”
6. Matthew 5:7 – “Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.”
7. Matthew 5:8 – “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.”
8. Matthew 5:9 – “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.”
9. Matthew 5:10 – “Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness’ sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.”
10. Matthew 5:11 – “Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account.”
11. Matthew 5:12a – “Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven,
12. Matthew 5:12b – “For so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.”
