

1. John 4:24 –“God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.”
2. Psalm 29: 1 –“Ascribe to the LORD, O heavenly beings, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.”
3. Psalm 29: 1-2 –“Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness.”
4. Psalm 29: 1 – 3 –“The voice of the LORD is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over many waters. ”
5. Psalm 29: 1 – 4 –“The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.”
6. Psalm 29: 1 - 5 –“The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars; the LORD breaks the cedars of Lebanon. ”
7. Psalm 29: 1- 6 – “He makes Lebanon to skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young wild ox.”
8. Psalm 29: 1 – 8 –“The voice of the LORD flashes forth flames of fire. The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; the LORD shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.”
9. Psalm 29: 1- 9 – “The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth and strips the forests bare, and in his temple all cry, “Glory!”
10. Psalm 29: 1- 10 –“The LORD sits enthroned over the flood; the LORD sits enthroned as king forever.”
11. Psalm 29: 1 – 11 – “May the LORD give strength to his people! May the LORD bless his people with peace!”
12. Numbers 6:24-26 –“ The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.”
13. Review Week (John 4:24, Psalm 29, & Numbers 6:24-26)

Note to teacher: These students have already memorized Psalm 100 twice in the time they have been in Sunday School, so we are encouraging them to memorize all of Psalm 29 instead this quarter.
